User journey is hard and keep motivating myself to go with the flow

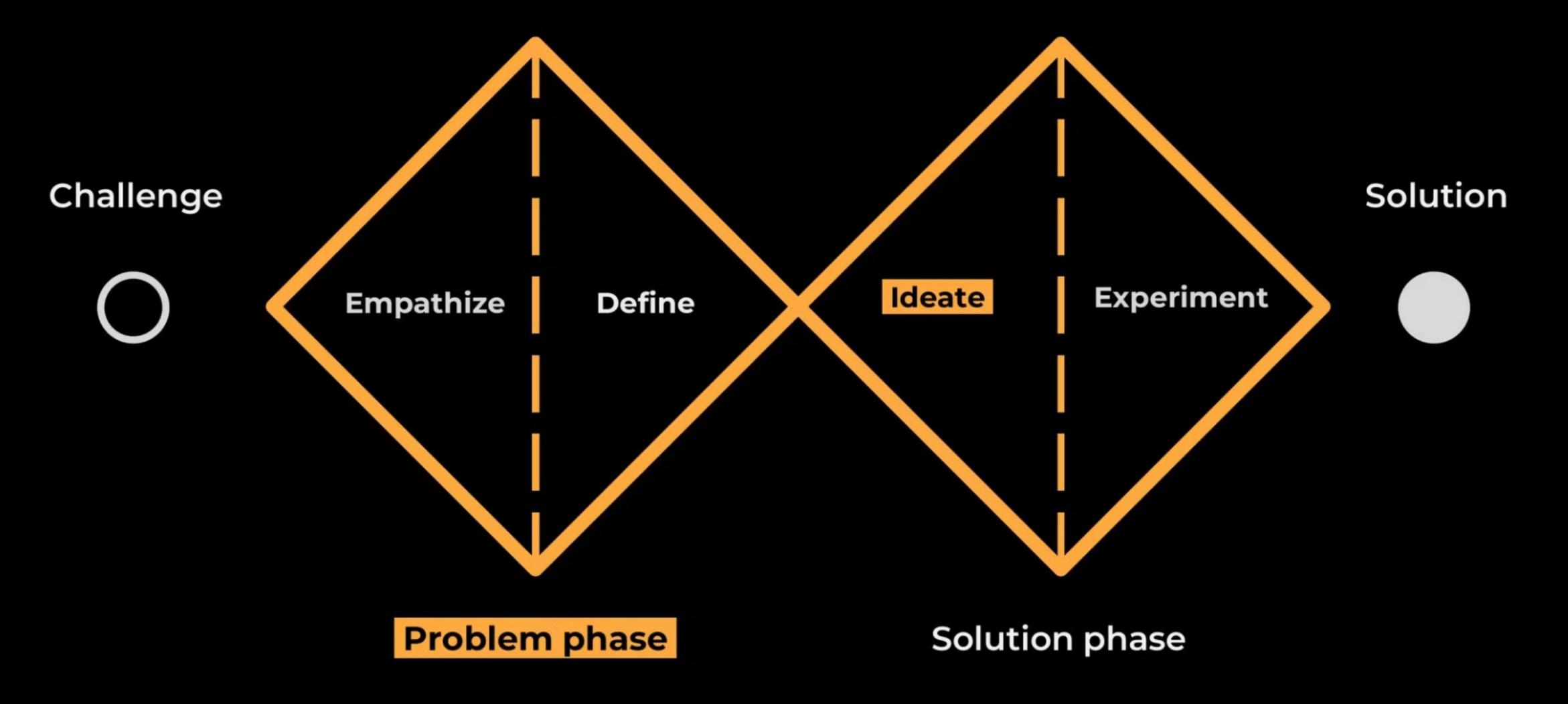
Every time the process becomes a bit harder, hovewer I am still interested

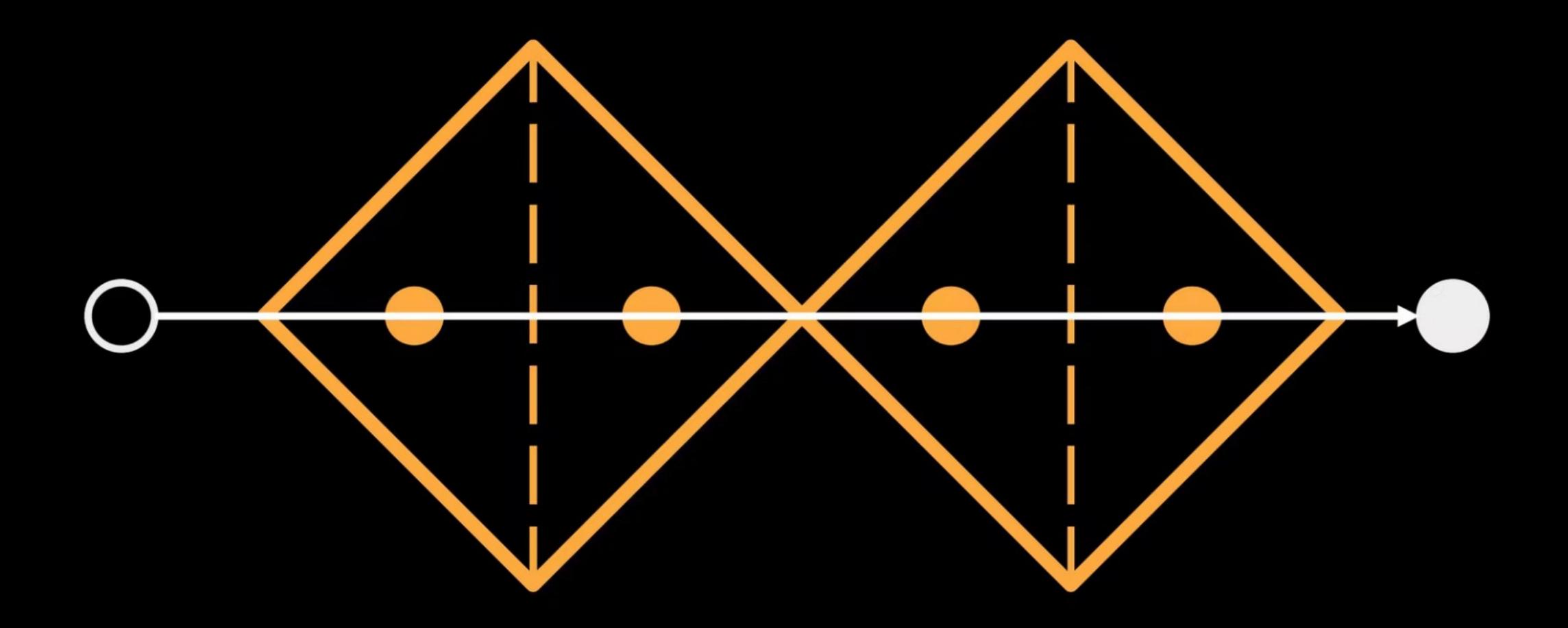
Making user journey is really time consuming and quite hard

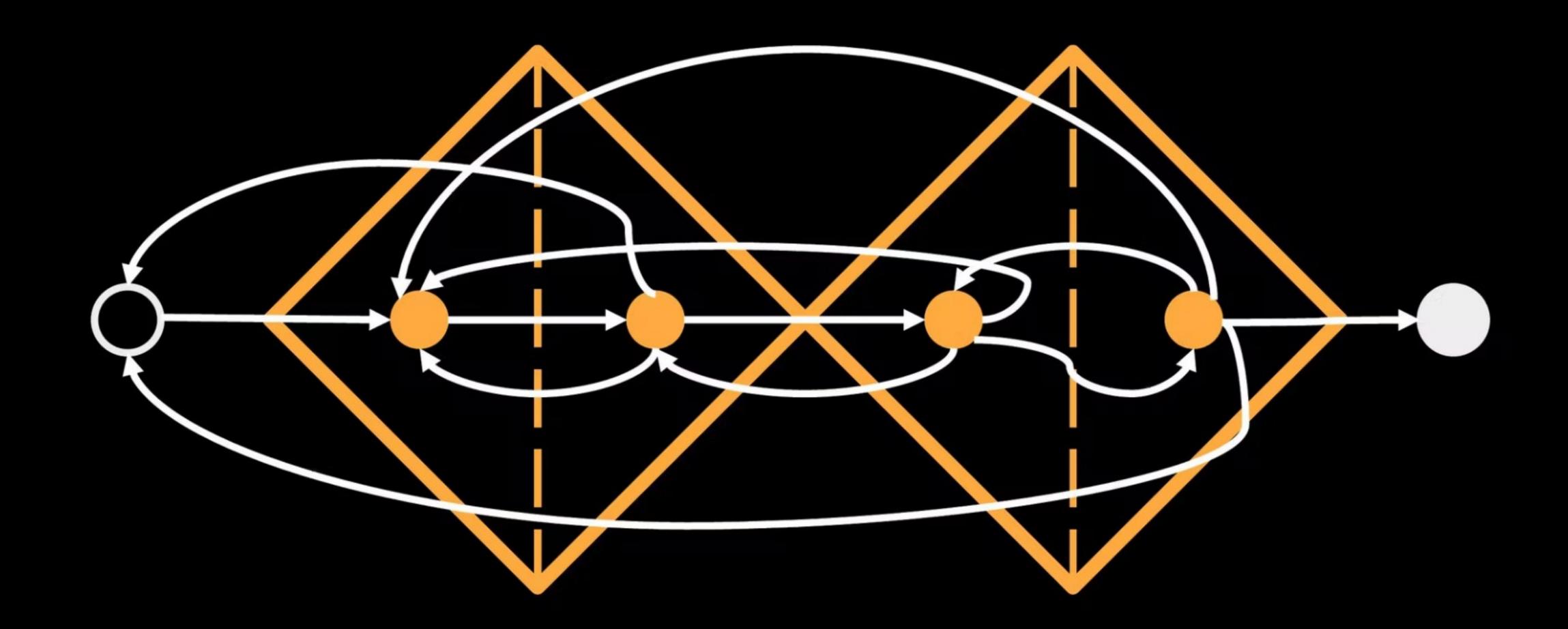
it was a little hard for me to start thinking broadly, but with little imagination it became easier

### What to do to have ideas?

Brainstorm, sketch, look around

general education, hobbys

look around and just think

brainstorming, looking for solution

Change of scenery, find inspiration

inspire, critical situation

Generate them by associating ideas with your hobbies, things you have seen books etc.

### Key points

### **Everyone is creative**

Lawyers trend to be particularly creative.

### Team brainstorm = bad

Always start with an individual reflection and then discuss as a team.

### Quantity before quality

Do not limit your thinking, do not judge your ideas.

### **Context first**

Research context before ideating, early ideation are generally pointless.

# It is an incremental process

Ideas are meant to evolve and transform. Embrace feedback.

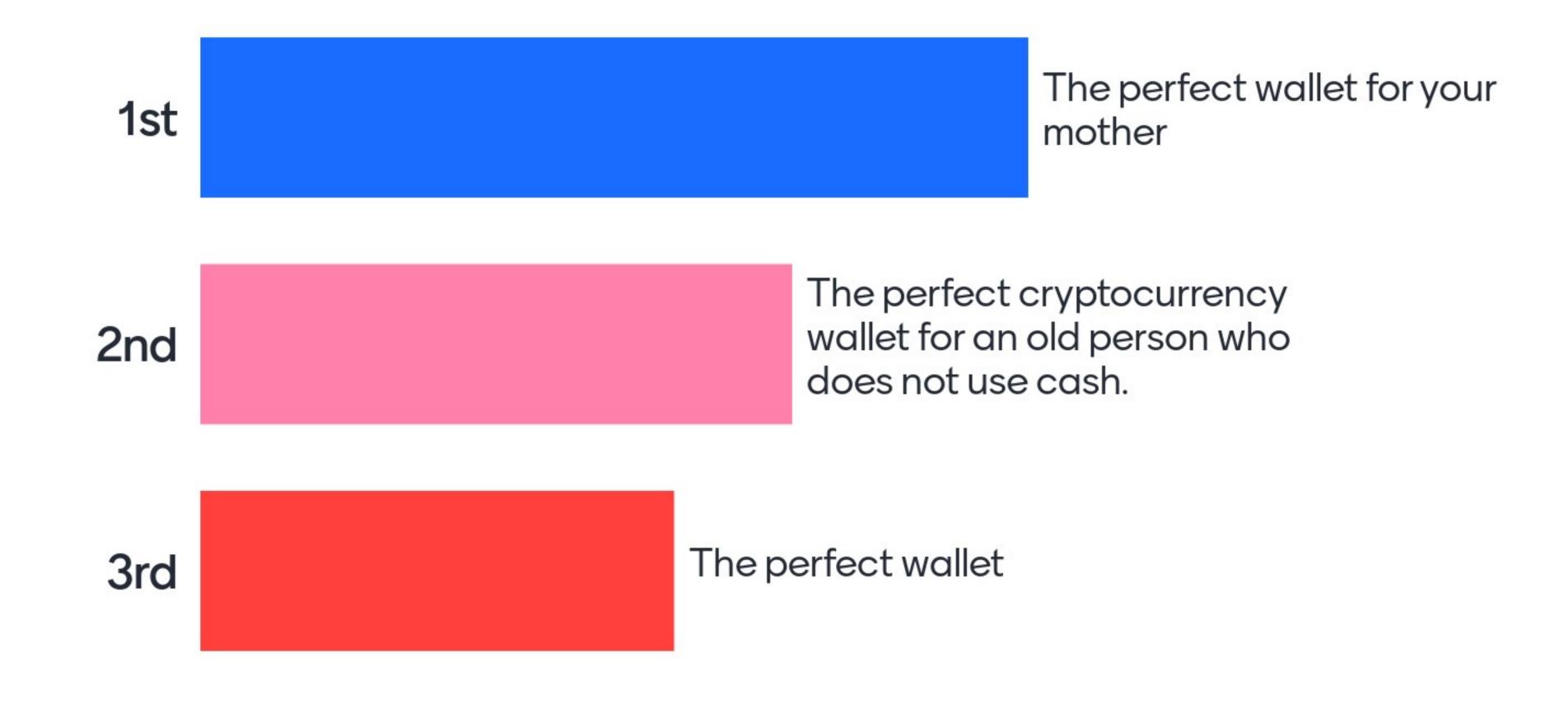
